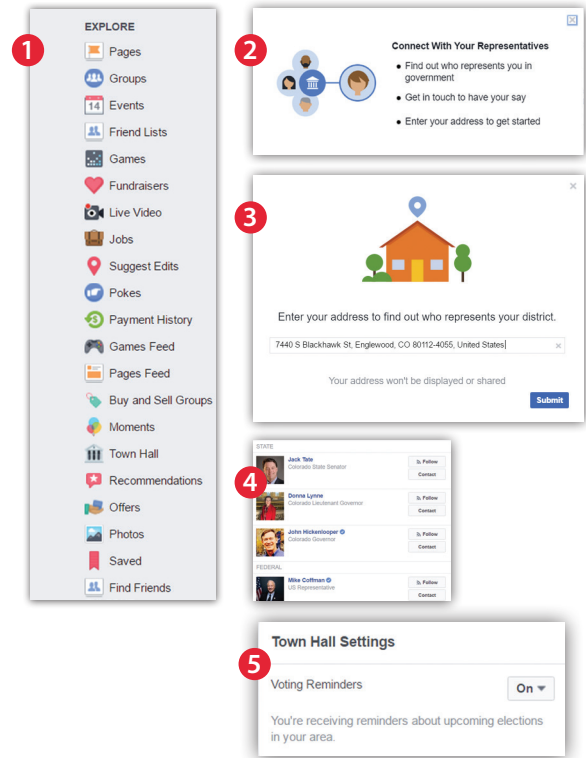


## Using Facebook's Town Hall

### TUTORIAL Getting Started With Town Hall

Setting up Town Hall is easy. It takes just a few minutes to enter your information and get started.

1. On your home page, in the left column, under EXPLORE, click **Town Hall**. If you don't see it there, go to [facebook.com/townhall](https://facebook.com/townhall).
2. You'll see a screen titled Connect With Your Representatives. Choose **Skip** to skip this step, or **Enter Address** to continue.
3. When prompted, enter your street address and click **Submit**.
4. Now that you're signed up for Town Hall, you'll see a list of your state and federal representatives, with the option to follow or contact them.
5. To the right of the representative list, you'll see a box titled Town Hall Settings. Toggle the Voting Reminders switch to **On** so you'll get reminders about upcoming elections.



### TUTORIAL Engaging With Your Representatives

Once you're up and running with Town Hall, start using it to engage with your elected officials.

1. For each representative, click **Follow** to follow that person on Facebook; you'll now see their posts in your feed. If you click **Contact**, you'll see a screen with contact information.
2. You can return to this page any time you want to connect with your representative.
3. You'll also notice that if you like or comment on a representative's post, you may be prompted to contact them. Just click the **Contact** button to continue.
