

TUTORIAL:

E-Mailing a Webpage

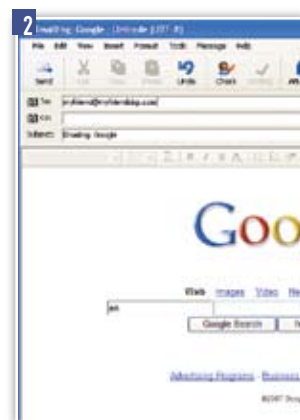
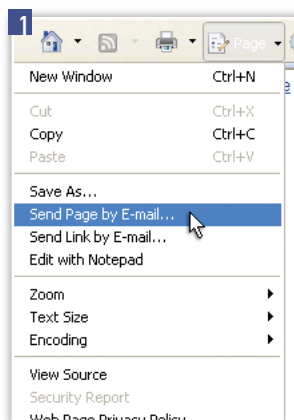
Have you ever come across a webpage that you'd like to share with someone else? Most browsers make this process quick and easy. You can either send your friend a link to the webpage, or you can send them the page's entire contents.

Here's how it works in Internet Explorer 7:

STEP 1. Click your cursor arrow on the "Page" menu and select "Send Page by E-mail..." or "Send Link by E-mail."

STEP 2. Your e-mail program opens and displays a new message window with either the webpage displayed in it or a webpage link attached to it.

STEP 3. Type an e-mail address in the "To:" field, type a message to your friend if you'd like, and then click "Send."

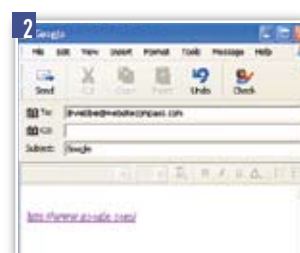
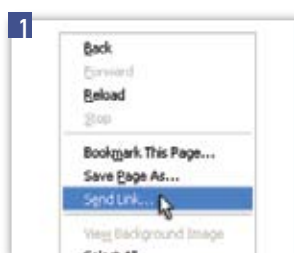


Here's how it works in Firefox:

STEP 1. Right click your cursor arrow on the background of the page. Choose "Send Link" from the context menu.

STEP 2. Your e-mail program opens and displays a new message window with either the webpage displayed in it or a webpage link attached to it.

STEP 3. Type an e-mail address in the "To:" field, type a message to your friend if you'd like, and then click "Send."

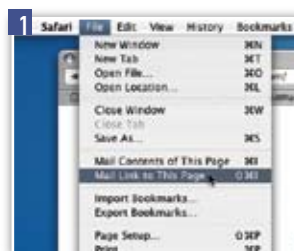


Here's how it works in Safari:

STEP 1. From the File menu, choose either "Mail Contents of This Page" or "Mail Link to This Page."

STEP 2. Your e-mail program opens and displays a new message window with either the webpage displayed in it or a webpage link attached to it.

STEP 3. Type an e-mail address in the "To:" field, type a message to your friend if you'd like, and then click "Send."



As an alternative, you can simply copy the URL address of the webpage's link and paste it within an e-mail message.
