

## TUTORIAL: FILTERING WEB CONTENT IN INTERNET EXPLORER

Using Internet Explorer 6 in Windows XP Home Edition

- STEP 1.** Since the current content ratings system that Internet Explorer uses by default is outdated, you'll first need to install an updated ratings system. With Internet Explorer open, go to the Internet Content Rating Association's site—[www.icra.org](http://www.icra.org).
- STEP 2.** Click on the "ICRAplus" link listed under the "Parents" section in the left column on the page.
- STEP 3.** Click the "Continue" link under the "Next steps" section at the bottom of the page.
- STEP 4.** Click the "Continue" button.
- STEP 5.** Click on the "Download" link next to the ICRAplus core module to download it.
- STEP 6.** Click the "Save" button in the "Download - Security Warning" window that pops open to save the file to your hard drive.
- STEP 7.** Choose where you want to save the file in the "Save As" dialog box and then click the "Save" button. Close the "Download complete" window if it's still open.
- STEP 8.** Click the "Download" link to the right of "RDFLabel." Then follow Steps 5 & 6 again to finish downloading the file.
- STEP 9.** Close Internet Explorer. Double-click the "icraplus" installer file from wherever you saved it.
- STEP 10.** Select "English" as the default setup language and click "Next."
- STEP 11.** Read the Terms and Conditions. If you agree, click "Yes."
- STEP 12.** Click the "Next" button. Then click the "Install" button.
- STEP 13.** Enter your desired passwords and security question and click "Accept."
- STEP 14.** Check "No, I will restart my computer later" and then click the "OK" button to finish the ICRAplus module installation.
- STEP 15.** Double-click the "RDFLabel" installer file to begin installing it.
- STEP 16.** Enter the password you selected in Step 13 and click the "Accept" button. Then click "Finish" to finish the installation.
- STEP 17.** Click the "Yes, I want to restart my computer now" button and then click "OK."
- STEP 18.** After restarting, you should see a blue star at the bottom-right of your desktop. Right-click this star and select "Administration."
- STEP 19.** Enter the "Default" as the username and the password you selected in Step 13. Then click "OK."
- STEP 20.** Internet Explorer will open with the ICRAplus settings page. Click the "Block/allow content types" link.
- STEP 21.** Change the settings on the "Block/allow content types" to your preferences. (To change block or allow preferences under a section, you may have to uncheck the "Only allow if none of the above" section.) Then click the "Apply" button.
- STEP 22.** You can manage other ICRAplus preferences using the links on the left hand side of the page.
- STEP 23.** You can deactivate, logout, or get help for ICRAplus by right-clicking the blue star at the lower right of your screen.
